## Commencement set for Mountaineer

There's nothing like a football Saturday at Mountaineer



Field. Now that same electricity and excitement of a fall afternoon will fill the air for WVU's graduation exercises.

WVU President David C. Hardesty Jr. announced Monday that Commencement ceremonies will be staged at the 63,500-seat stadium at 1:30 p.m. May 14—rain or shine.

"As we continue our campus-wide WVU 2000 celebration, we are thrilled to announce this new location for a very special graduation 2000," Hardesty said. "As most people know, our traditional home for graduation—the Coliseum—has been closed since August. We have staged other events like New Student Convocation and December Convocation at the Creative Arts Center very successfully. I feel confident this new venue will also work out well."

Besides plenty of seating, the double-deck stadium offers a scoreboard messaging center, parking, plenty of handicapped seating, restrooms, concessions, tailgating and more.

This is the first time WVU has staged commencement outdoors—at least in recent memory. Former locations for graduation ceremonies include the Old Field House, now Stansbury Hall, and the former Reynolds Hall, a building where the Mountainlair now stands.

## More than 70 apply for top WVU-P job

Seventy-eight applications have been received thus far for the presidency of WVU at Parkersburg, according to search committee chair Karen LaRoe, president of WVU Institute of Technology.

Applicants represent 31 states and one foreign country and include professionals from higher education institutions, the public sector, business and industry.

Dr. LaRoe said the field is being narrowed, and telephone interviews with semi-finalists are beginning this week, while additional applications continue to be accepted and considered.

WVU Parkersburg President Eldon Miller announced in September that he would retire in June 2000. Dr. Miller joined WVU at Parkersburg in 1982.

A new campus president and regional vice president of WVU is expected by July.

## U birthday, 'new' library to be celebrated Feb. 7

Celebration of the University's founding on Feb. 7, 1867, and renovations to the Evansdale Library will be combined this year into an event at the library, which recently enjoyed extensive upgrades.

The event is scheduled from 1-2:30 p.m. Monday, Feb. 7. Historical displays of WVU and the University Libraries will be available. Speakers are President David C. Hardesty Jr., Provost Gerald Lang, Libraries Dean Frances O'Brien and Evansdale Library Director Jo Ann Calzonetti. Refreshments, including birthday cake, will be served.

Dr. O'Brien said the Evansdale Library, completed in 1980, was "very nice for that era."

In today's high-tech information age, however, an overhaul was required. After more than \$1 million in renovations, the library is not only more pleasing to be in, but also is equipped with 21st century electronic information systems.

Combining the rededication with WVU's anniversary will celebrate this move forward and will reflect the University's goals of providing improved research and education facilities, the dean said.

While work progresses on the Wise library addition downtown, the Evansdale Library already offers a new 30-workstation electronic classroom with audio-visual capabilities and expanded public computer access with 26 workstations. Also, patrons have access to 20 wireless laptop computers.

Also, Ethernet connections are available where patrons can use their own laptop computers within easy reach of library resources.

"It's the same building," Calzonetti said, "but it really is a different library. We've even gotten rid of the 1970s colors, which most patrons found to be not conducive to research and study."

## Engineer named head of Physical Plant

A professional engineer with 20 years of experience in planning, construction and maintenance operations has been appointed director of WVU's Physical Plant.

Lee D. Comer, physical plant director at Lake Superior State University in Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., was selected from among 70 applicants, said Joe Fisher, assistant vice president for Facilities and Services. He will begin his new job Feb. 21.

Comer replaces Bob Cremer, who retired June 30 after three years as director. Paul Walden, assistant director of resource management, has been serving as interim director.

"I think Lee Comer is going to bring an excellent blend of technical knowledge and experience to the organization," Fisher said. "He comes well recommended, and his resume speaks volumes about his background and skills."

Physical Plant, a division of Facilities and Services, is responsible for the planning, construction, maintenance and operation of campus build-

ings and utilities. The unit has 400 employees.

Comer, who grew up in Battle Creek, Mich., has been physical plant director at Lake Superior State since 1996. Before that, he was director of facilities services for the Horseheads (N.Y.) Central School District from 1992-96. He worked for IBM in Endicott, N.Y., from 1979-92, starting as a mechanical engineer in facilities engineering and rising to the position of manager of environmental systems engineering.

He has a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from Michigan Technological University and a master's in business administration from Lake Superior State. He is also a licensed professional engineer in Michigan and New York.

Comer said he looks forward to the challenge of working at a larger university. WVU has more than 22,000 students.

"I like the idea of coming to a flagship institution like WVU," he said. "I'm very impressed with the University and Physical Plant."

## Hungarian transportation officials to visit U

Two transportation officials from Hungary will visit the WVU campus Jan. 29-Feb. 3 to tour the West Virginia Transportation Technology Transfer Center.

The visiting officials will be Timea Kadas, public relations assistant for the Hungarian Ministry of Transport, Telecommunication and Water Management; and Atilla Mocsari, transport and traffic engineer for State Road Management Co., Hajdu-Bihar County, Hungary.

Their visit is the first step toward establishing a partnership between the West Virginia center and a future Hungarian center. Kadas and Mocsari will also visit similar centers in Pennsylvania and Ohio.

While in West Virginia, Kadas and Mocsari will meet with various officials and local engineering professionals. They will also have the opportunity to observe several projects and to speak with local officials regarding the use of gas-well brines for roadway snow and ice removal.

Funded by the Federal Highway Administration and the West Virginia Department of Transportation, the West Virginia Transportation Technology Transfer Center is housed in the Civil and Environmental Engineering Department of WVU. The center provides training and technical assistance for state and municipal highway maintenance personnel and is part of the national Local Technical Assistance Program.

## Speakers announced for Jan. 31

A University-wide information forum on asbestos management will be held from 3:30-5 p.m. Monday, Jan. 31, at the Mountainlair Gluck Theater. The forum, sponsored by Faculty Senate, will feature several experts on various aspects of asbestos who will present brief presentations followed by a question and answer period.

Speakers include:

- **Randy Curtis**, the director of the West Virginia Bureau of Public Health Division of Radiation, Toxics and Indoor Air. He is a registered professional engineer and holds a bachelor's degree in civil engineering as well as a master's degree in environmental studies. He has been employed by West Virginia State government for more than 20 years and has worked in areas of highway engineering, solid waste management and sanitary engineering.

Curtis is charged with operating programs for radiological health, radon mitigation, asbestos control, lead poisoning prevention and indoor air quality. He has been instrumental in the development of three state laws that provide for the certification and licensing of environmental professionals. He also worked in the private environmental consulting and contracting sector for six years where he was involved in several environmental projects involving underground storage tanks and environmental remediation. He is a member of the National Environmental Health Association and the West Virginia Public Health Association.

- **John P. Walsh**, an executive director with ManTech International Corp., an environmental consulting firm with offices nationwide.

Walsh heads the Rockville, Md. office for ManTech, known as the Building Environmental Division—ManTech's center-of-excellence for building-related environmental issues such as asbestos, lead and indoor air quality.

Walsh has been with ManTech for more than five years, and has been providing building-related consulting for 12 years. He has testified numerous times as an expert witness on

asbestos issues and has provided asbestos services in nearly every state. Walsh earned a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from Duke University.

- **Dr. Vincent Castranova**, an authority on the toxicology of substances inhaled through occupational exposure, is the branch chief of pathology and physiology research at the National Institute of Occupational Health Safety and Health in Morgantown. Castranova holds a Ph.D. in physiology and also is a NIOSH distinguished scientist fellow, a professor in the WVU Department of Physiology and a professor in the WVU Department of Basic Pharmaceutical Sciences.

He has been employed by NIOSH since 1977, rising to his current position of branch chief, and has had an adjunct appointment at WVU since first joining NIOSH. Castranova has been a member of the Society of Toxicology for 20 years and a member of the SOT Inhalation Speciality Section for 15 of those years, with two years as section councilor. He has edited two books and authored/co-authored over 200 publications on mechanisms of toxicity of inhaled substances.

- **Roger Pugh**, director of Environmental Health and Safety at WVU, a position he has held for more than 20 years. He earned a master's degree in safety and environmental management from WVU's College of Engineering and Mineral Resources. Pugh has authored and published several journal articles and books on safety and fire protection-related subjects.

He is the past president of the West Virginia Safety Council and currently chairs both the National Safety Council's Division of Campus Safety and the Campus Safety Health and Environmental Management Association. He also taught several EPA-certified asbestos classes, including inspector, planner, worker, supervisor and designer.

WVU officials also have extended an invitation to the Environmental Protection Agency—Region III to send a representative to the forum.

## Apparent low bid identified for Coliseum work

The apparent low bidder on the WVU Coliseum asbestos abatement project is USA Remediation Services Inc. of Warrenton, Va., Joe Fisher, assistant vice president for facilities and services, announced Monday.

USA Remediation was one of six firms to bid on the multimillion-dollar project to remove the sprayed-on fireproofing insulation material from the arena's concrete dome and replace it with a suitable material. The firm's total bid was \$7.8 million; a \$5.8 million base bid for the dome area, \$1.3 million for work in select hallways and rooms in the outer concourse and \$563,000 to replace bleachers.

Bids ranged from a low of \$7.8 million to a high of about \$14.6 million.

"The bids were very favorable, with three firms tightly grouped," Fisher said. "USA Remediation met all the pre-qualifying specifications and then came in at the lowest price. We will now go through some additional approval steps like having Apex, our professional consultants, review and analyze the three lowest bids and consult with our purchasing department, administrators and Board before taking the paperwork to Charleston."

He added, "But I can honestly say that we are happy to have this process behind us so that we can now move forward on the important work that lies ahead."

USA Remediation Services should get started no later than March 1 — sooner, if possible — erecting the 150-foot-high scaffolding that will be necessary to reach the basketball arena's domed ceiling. The contract calls for the work to be completed within 230 days of the notice to proceed, Fisher said, putting the projected completion date at Oct. 17 — prior to the start of basketball practice.

The 14,000-seat arena has been sealed and closed to the public since August. Most offices in the outer ring are now relocated to leased office facilities around Morgantown, with the remaining athletic offices and staff to be relocated next month. Classes have been moved to other campus locations and athletic contests are being played at other Morgantown and state sites.

Asbestos-containing material coats the ceiling of the 30-year-old facility. Such products were commonly used worldwide in the 1960s and early 1970s as a fireproofing and insulation material before their dangers were discovered.

While regular air monitoring and testing by WVU and a third party contractor indicated no health risks to occupants, WVU in cooperation with the EPA, closed the Coliseum arena in August when agreement could not be reached on testing protocols.

To help communicate information on the upcoming project and status of other campus facilities, WVU's Faculty Senate will host a University-wide Information Forum on Asbestos Management Monday, Jan. 31, from 3:30-5:30

## Legislative round-up: Bills that would impact higher education

In the first two weeks of the legislative session, a number of bills affecting higher education have been introduced.

These are some of the bills faculty and staff will watch the progress of in coming weeks:

**House Bill 2201:** Tuition and fee waivers for children and spouses of full-time faculty and staff members at state institutions of higher education.

**HB 2337:** Providing retirement credit to teachers for years of service at private four-year colleges and universities.

**HB 2373:** Promulgating a rule



regarding faculty status for college librarians.

**HB 2426:** Increasing from 20 to 30 the allowable years of service used in calculating salary increments for state employees and including employees of higher education governing boards.

**HB 2432:** Providing retirement service credit for certain employees of the West Virginia University extension service.

**HB 2728:** Permitting persons 60 years of age or older to attend colleges or universities without payment of tuition and fees as space permits.

## U, Concord sign McNair Scholar agreement

WVU President David C. Hardesty Jr. and Concord College President Jerry Beasley signed an agreement Wednesday in Charleston that will enable McNair Scholars at Concord to obtain tuition waivers at WVU. The McNair students who have obtained a baccalaureate degree from Concord will receive tuition waivers if accepted into a WVU graduate program.

The agreement will allow two McNair Scholars per year to obtain the waivers. If the awardees enroll in a M.S. program, they will receive financial assistance for up to three

years, and up to five years for a doctoral program. The students' continued receipt of the waivers is contingent on good academic standing and progress toward the degree selected, the leaders explained.

The McNair Scholars Program was established in honor of the second African-American astronaut, Ronald E. McNair.

The program targets first-generation college students with financial need or those who are underrepresented in their field.

## U center coordinates public service campaign to promote end-of-life care

WVU's Center for Ethics and Law is coordinating a public service campaign promoting the West Virginia Initiative to Improve End-of-Life Care.

Two public service announcements, one featuring U.S. Sen. Jay Rockefeller and one featuring Gov. Cecil Underwood, are being broadcast on television stations all over West Virginia in January and February. Each ad will display the organization's toll-free number (877-209-8086).

The campaign was funded by \$135,000 in grants from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and the Claude Worthington Benedum Foundation.

"We want to let citizens of the state know that care for people in their last days and months is important and that the West Virginia Initiative to Improve End-of-Life Care can be a valuable resource to them," said James Keresztury, project manager.

Another grant from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation will fund a study on the effectiveness of the cam-

paign. A public relations firm has been hired to conduct a random telephone survey that will be used to gauge awareness of the Initiative.

"Our goal is to see if we were successful in getting more people aware of our service and of end-of-life care," Keresztury said.

The initiative includes organizations such as the West Virginia's Hospice Council, State Medical Association, Hospital Association, State Bar and Council of Churches.

The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, based in Princeton, N.J., is the nation's largest philanthropy devoted exclusively to health and health care.

The Foundation concentrates its grantmaking in three areas: to assure that all Americans have access to basic health care at reasonable cost; to improve the way services are organized and provided to people with chronic health conditions; and to reduce the harm caused by substance abuse.

## Water line break on University Avenue closes University Services Center

WVU employees who work in the University Services Center got a half day off Tuesday after a water line break on University Avenue forced University officials to close the building.

The water line break occurred early Tuesday morning as a result of the cold weather, Morgantown Utility Board officials said. The break shut down water flow into the building.

University officials were originally going to keep the building open because nearby businesses offered to let employees use their restrooms, said Scott Kelley, vice president for administration and finance.

The University then learned that the gas would have to be

shut off before workers could repair the line, he said. The workers encountered damage to a gas line while trying to fix the water line.

Unsure of when water and gas service would be restored, officials closed the building before noon and sent most of the employees home for the rest of the day. Department of Public Safety employees, who are considered essential personnel, remained on the job.

Workers repaired the water line by 2 p.m., and the building reopened Wednesday.

The USC houses several units, including DPS, Facilities and Services, Environmental Health and Safety, Department of Human Resources and the Parking Office.

In order to give more of the students a chance to sing a major role, Thieme has divided some of the larger roles so that one singer will portray a character in Acts 1 and 4, while another will sing the part in Acts 2 and 3.
